Chart 1 – Performance against Overall 15 month target (target 1 above)

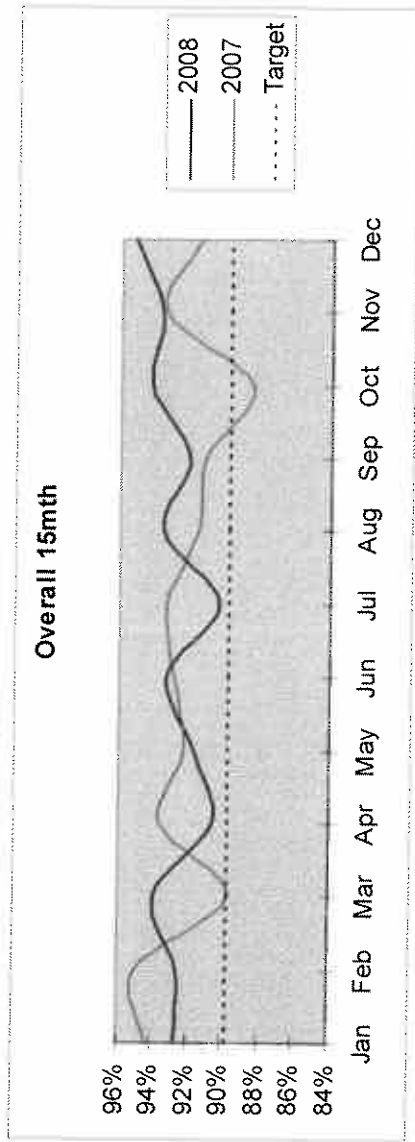


Chart 2 – Performance against Investigation 6 month target (target 2 above)
