2. At the end of May 2010, the accumulated number of panel actual hearing days for the year was 1,363. This compares to 986 at the same period in 2009.

3. The Interim Orders Panel sat for 29 days in April 2010 and 24 days in May 2010. 448 interim orders were in place at the end of May 2010, compared to 404 at the end of May 2009.

4. Hearing room utilisation was 86% in April 2010 and 93% in May 2010, against a target of 80%.
