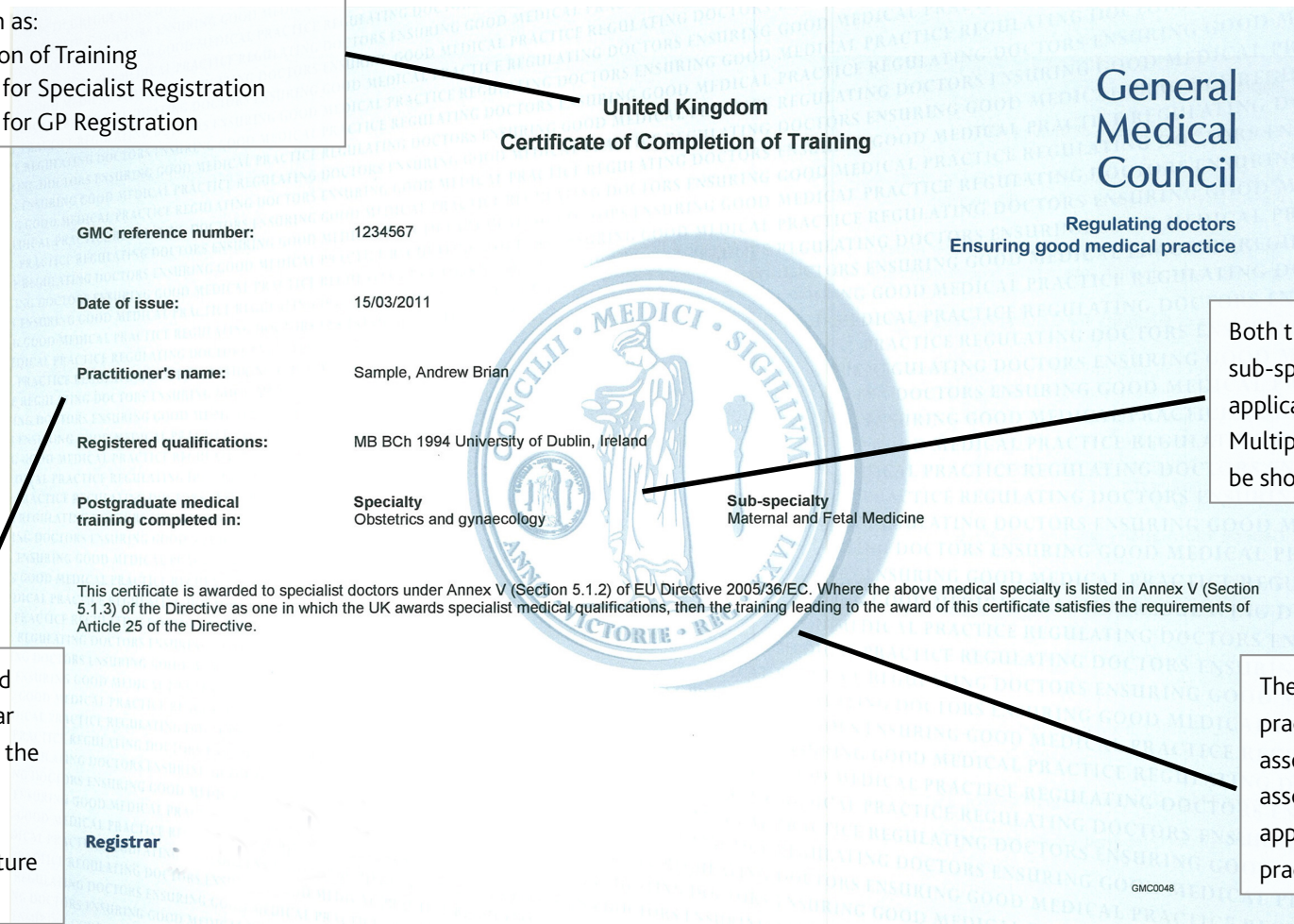


Changes to certificates of eligibility for entry onto the Specialist Register and GP Register and Certificates of Completion of Training from 28 March 2011

Certificate titles remain as:
 Certificate of Completion of Training
 Certificate of Eligibility for Specialist Registration
 Certificate of Eligibility for GP Registration



Both the specialty and sub-specialty (where applicable) are now shown. Multiple specialties will also be shown if applicable.

Practitioner's details and date of issue now appear on the left-hand side of the certificate.

 There is no longer a picture of the practitioner.

The eligibility criteria the practitioner has been assessed against, and any associated legislation, now appear below the practitioner's details.
