

## Developments

Report	Description
All	The export function for tabular data has now been switched on allowing users to download extracts in various formats. The recommended format of the data is crosstab.
ARCP postgraduate	Option to display select results at the nation level added.
Exam	Option to display select results at the nation level added.
F1 Preparedness	For survey years from 2015 onwards, an overall F1 preparedness indicator has been calculated in a similar manner to the indicators used in the NTS reporting tool.
F1 Preparedness	We've now included responses from doctors in training for where the year they began medical school is unknown. These were filtered out last year, but are now included, in the filter "year commenced medical school".
Recruitment	We have added the round one outcomes for recruitment outcome for August 2017.
Specialty Destination	We have a new visualisation which shows the proportion of doctors by year of primary medical qualification who are in different cohorts of doctors. The cohorts include All, Any Specialist or GP, Both Specialist & GP and In PG Training. The definitions of these are consistent with 2016 (exc. Both Specialist & GP) and will be added to the UTR webpage once this has been updated to the new format. We have added a filter by medical school so that you can see the mixture of doctors they produce by year of primary medical qualification.
Specialty Destination	We have a new visualisation which shows the proportion of doctors by year of primary medical qualification that fall in various specialty groups. We have added a filter by medical school so that you can see the mixture of doctors they produce by year of primary medical qualification. Please note doctors that are both on the Specialist and GP registers are not included in the individual specialty groups in this particular report.
Specialty Destination	We have removed the registration status filter from the data which allowed erased and suspended cohorts to be broken out. Instead the report now includes all doctors who received their Primary Medical Qualification from 1991

	onwards excluding only those doctors whose status is "Not Registered". Erased and suspended doctors are therefore included in all figures.
Specialty Destination	We have replaced the year of first registration with year of primary medical qualification to align with other reports available through the GMC but also so that cohorts are defined by their admitting year.
Specialty Destination	We have removed the year of first registration filter from the report leaving only year commenced medical school.
Specialty Destination	We have changed the Royal College of Physicians to be Royal Colleges (plural) of Physicians as they are made up of three different colleges.
Specialty Destination	We have created a new cohort of doctors defined as "Both Specialist and GP". As the number of doctors in this cohort is very small we have grouped them together rather than showing the specific specialty group they are assigned to with the Royal College of General Practitioners.
