

ARCP and RITA Data Collection 2012 – Briefing Note 2

Introduction

The GMC and COPMeD undertake an annual joint project to report on trainee doctors' progress (Annual Review of Competence Progression (ARCP) and Record of In Training Assessment (RITA) data) through specialty, including GP, training programmes

This technical briefing note is for Postgraduate Deanery teams who provide ARCP and RITA outcome data to the GMC each year.

This note covers the ARCP/RITA data for the training year 2011 to 2012.

This note should be read in conjunction with *Reference Tables Used For ARCP Validation.xls* circulated with this note. Anyone involved in preparing the submission should view both.

Changes from Briefing Note 1

Please note the following minor changes from Briefing Note 1.

1. All ARCP/RITA events and their outcomes (there may be multiple outcomes for one event) that occurred between Wednesday 3rd August 2011 and **Tuesday 31st July 2012 and not 7th August as stated previously.**
2. Date of expected revalidation is not required as there is a separate process underway to cover this. It remains on the validation spreadsheet described below for use next year, but will only generate a warning validation message.

3. The following fields have been added to the extract: First Name, Surname, ARCP (whether an outcome was awarded Yes/No)
4. An expanded list of academic trainee values is now in use, please see the table below.

Submission instructions

1. Please ensure that the system you will be working from has the following programme versions installed: Microsoft Excel 2003-2010 and Microsoft Access 2003-2007. Please note that if you used the NTS validation tool in 2012, this tool is similar.
2. Log into GMC Connect, and open up the 'ARCP 2012 Data Validation Tool' folder (all deaneries have access to this folder)
3. The 2012 ARCP Data folder will contain a zip file with an Access database and an Excel file. Download this zip file and save it on your network.
4. Extract the two files (*ARCP Data Validation Tool - Version 1.0.xls* and *ARCPRefData.mdb*) within the zip file, saving them in the same folder.
5. Open up the *ARCP Data Validation Tool - Version 1.0.xls* file you have just downloaded, extracted and saved, ensuring Macros are enabled.
6. The Tool contains two tabs:
 - a. Tab 1: '*Summary*.' This page gives you a summary of your data validation progress, including the number of different errors you currently have in your data, and the total numbers of valid and invalid records. This page also contains the deanery selection list, and the 'Validate Data' button.
 - b. Tab 2: '*ARCP data*.' This is where you need to paste all of your outcome data for the 2012 ARCP return, ensuring the column order is correct. It contains a column for each of the data variables outlined in Part 2 of this guide. To the right of these, it also contains a column for each of the possible validation errors, which are explained in Part 3 of the guide.
7. Paste all of your outcome data into the '*ARCP Data*' tab, making sure you paste all of the data into the correct columns (the order in which the data variables are listed in the data validation tool may not match your extract).
8. Please make sure there are no blank rows in the middle of these pasted data, as this will cause an error in the validation process.

9. Once you have placed all your outcome data into the correct columns, go to the first tab of the spreadsheet ('Summary'), select your Deanery and click the validate button. The process may take a couple of minutes.
10. The Validation Tool will scan through all of the data in the 'ARCP data' tab, and then present you with a summary of any errors that have been found
11. Go back to the ARCP data tab and review columns BI to DL to see detail of any errors that have been identified. Each column identifies a different potential error in the data. The fields and validation checks are listed in the table below.
12. When you have removed the errors please save the file using the following format
ARCP Data Validation Tool_<<Deanery 3 character code>>_ddmmmyyyy.xls
13. Please submit this Excel file via GMC Connect. Each Deanery now has a '2012 ARCP Data' folder, to access this please log-in to GMC Connect. Deanery staff, who had access to the 2011 ARCP folder, will have access to this 2012 folder. Please email dsmith@gmc-uk.org when you have submitted the file.
14. This year these data will not be loaded into the GMC's main Siebel database (as was the case with the NTS submissions). It will as per last year be loaded into the database used for reporting the previous two year's results.
15. Some additional validation checks will take place centrally and you will receive feedback on these by 16th November 2012:
 - a. checks for duplicate records;
 - b. checks that the specialty the ARCP outcome refers to matches the specialty given in the NTN/DRN.
16. Any errors identified in step 16 will require correction by 30th November 2012.

ReadMe Sheet

To assist in our evaluation of the work and ensure nothing is lost, please document the following WITHIN the file on a separate worksheet:

1. Assumptions
2. Issues – for example notes on the reliability of a particular field
3. Source field of the data – this is especially important for Hicom deaneries for which we have been informed different deaneries are using different fields
4. Any formulae used to derive the values in a given field, if the value does not come directly from an existing field
5. Please include in your documentation anything you have previously raised with us to ensure nothing is lost.

Annex 1 – data specification repeated from Briefing Note with additional information on validation rules

Scope of ARCP/RITA Data Collection

The data should cover:

All ARCP/RITA events and their outcomes (there may be multiple outcomes for one event) that occurred between Wednesday 3rd August 2011 and Tuesday 31st July 2012.

and

All trainees in a deanery programme for any length of time during this reporting period.

Each row of the dataset should consist of one ARCP or RITA outcome per programme. For many events there will only be one row, but there are occasions when more than one row of data is required as follows:

Academic trainees will have one outcome for the academic component and one for the clinical component of their programme. [DN: for discussion]

Dual-CCT trainees may have one outcome per specialty. E.g. trainees with General (Internal) Medicine as second specialty should have a separate outcome recorded for this specialty.

If a trainee was in multiple programmes for a given ARCP event then there should be multiple rows in the return so that ALL the programmes the ARCP event refers to are listed. If a trainee was in Programme A for part of the period and Programme B for the second part of the period the ARCP refers to then there should be 2 rows of data

The specialty to which the ARCP refers to **must be the trainee's programme specialty**, as per their NTN or DRN. Please do not record a trainee's post specialty in the programme specialty field.

The data should NOT include: dentists or non-medical public health trainees as the GMC does not have a statutory responsibility for these trainees.

Equalities and Diversity Data - repeated from Briefing Note 1

Please do not include ED data. The GMC will link the ARCP/RITA data to ED data collected in the trainee survey. The collection notice on the screen for the ED questions in the Trainee Survey has been changed to make it clear the information trainees share will be used to help regulate medical education and make sure progression through GMC approved training programmes is fair and free from discrimination.
