

# TER1 – Restoration for doctors holding temporary emergency registration

## Application to restore registration

The UK government asked us to give temporary emergency registration (TER) to suitable people as part of the response to the Coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic under our powers covered by Section 18A of the Medical Act.

Your temporary emergency registration will only last for the duration of the emergency and should only be used to support the response to the pandemic. You can carry out activities including:

Treating coronavirus patients, including NHS patients treated in independent sector organisations	Backfilling in routine NHS clinical, or commissioned, services for colleagues who have been moved to treat coronavirus patients
Working in routine NHS clinical, or commissioned, services to clear backlogs created by the pandemic	Working in other roles linked to the pandemic including track and trace, NHS111 services or the vaccination programme

You should use this application if you were granted TER and you want to begin the process of transitioning to routine registration so you can return to work in areas that aren't related to the pandemic (including private practice or formal training posts) and/or work after the pandemic is over.

### What do you need to do?

- Arrange for your most recent employer to complete and return the [medical services \(TER3\) form](#).
- Check your email for updates on your application. You will be assigned a dedicated adviser who will look after your application. Your application adviser will be in touch (normally within 5 working days of receiving your application) after they have assessed your application and the information we currently hold on file to provide you with an update. They will let you know what evidence we need and the fees you need to pay to complete your application.
