On 14 December 2019 Dr Wood physically assaulted a female, in that during an argument he hit her in the face with his fist. This conduct does not meet with the standards required of a doctor. It risks bringing the profession into disrepute and it must not be repeated. The required standards are set out in Good medical practice and associated guidance. In particular paragraph 65 applies: You must make sure that your conduct justifies your patients' trust in you and the public's trust in the profession. Whilst this failing in itself is not so serious as to require any restriction on his registration, it is necessary in response to issue this formal warning.
