From 30 Aug 2024 to 30 Aug 2025

On 24 June 2024 a Tribunal found that, during a consultation on a date between August and October 2021, Dr Jeyapragash attempted to prevent a patient from speaking by holding his hand over their mouth. The Tribunal found that Dr Jeyapragash's actions were conducted without the patient's consent and amounted to a single episode of physically controlling behaviour. This conduct does not meet with the standards required of a doctor. It risks bringing the profession into disrepute and it must not be repeated. The required standards are set out in Good medical practice and associated guidance. In this case, the following paragraphs of Good medical practice are particularly relevant: "46. You must be polite and considerate. 47. You must treat patients as individuals and respect their dignity and privacy." Whilst this failing in itself is not so serious as to require any restriction on Dr Jeyapragash's registration, it is necessary in response to issue this formal warning.
