Furthermore, Dr Quest failed to notify the GMC of these convictions/incidents. This conduct does not meet with the standards required of a doctor. It risks undermining public protection, specifically public confidence in the profession and it must not be repeated. You must make sure that your conduct justifies patients' trust in you and the public's trust in your profession. 84. You must be honest in financial and commercial dealings with patients, employers, insurers, indemnifiers and other organisations or individuals. 99. You must tell us without delay if, anywhere in the world: a. you have accepted a caution (or equivalent) from a prosecuting authority b. you have been charged with a criminal offence in person or by post c. you have been found guilty of a criminal offence Whilst this failing in itself is not so serious as to require any restriction on Dr Quest's registration, it is necessary in response to issue this formal warning.
