On 15 November 2024 Dr Gerval was convicted of driving a motor vehicle with excess alcohol in her system. This does not meet the standards required of a doctor. It risks bringing the profession into disrepute and it must not be repeated. The required standards are set out in Good medical practice and associated guidance. In this case, paragraph 81 of Good medical practice is particularly relevant: You must make sure that your conduct justifies patients' trust in you and the public's trust in the profession. Whilst this failing in itself is not so serious as to require any restriction on her registration, it is necessary in response to issue this formal warning.
