1. He must personally ensure the GMC is notified of the following information within seven calendar days of the date these conditions become effective:

The details of his current post, including: i his job title ii his job location iii his responsible officer (or their nominated deputy) b the contact details of his employer and any contracting body, including his direct line manager c any organisation where he has practising privileges and/or admitting rights d any training programmes he is in e of the organisation on whose medical performers list he is included
2. He must personally ensure the GMC is notified: a of any post he accepts, before starting it b that all relevant people have been notified of his conditions, in accordance with condition 9. c if any formal disciplinary proceedings against him are started by his employer and/or contracting body, within seven calendar days of being formally notified of such proceedings d if any of his posts, practising privileges, or admitting rights have been suspended or terminated by his employer before the agreed date within seven calendar days of being notified of the termination e if he applies for a post outside the UK.
3. He must allow the GMC to exchange information with any person involved in monitoring his compliance with his conditions.
4. a. He must have a workplace reporter appointed by his responsible officer (or their nominated deputy). b. He must not work until: i. his responsible officer (or their nominated deputy) has appointed his workplace reporter ii. he has personally ensured that the GMC has been notified of the name and contact details of his workplace reporter.
5. a He must design a Personal Development Plan (PDP), with specific aims to address the deficiencies in the following areas of his practice: Record Keeping Clinical Administration (Hospital letters, reports and Pathology results) b His PDP must be approved by his responsible officer (or their nominated deputy). c He must give the GMC a copy of his approved PDP within three months of these substantive conditions becoming effective. d He must give the GMC a copy of his approved PDP on request. e. He must meet with his responsible officer (or their nominated deputy), as required, to discuss his achievements against the aims of his PDP.
6. a He must have an educational supervisor appointed by his responsible officer (or their nominated deputy)
7. a He must be supervised in all of his posts by a clinical supervisor, as defined in the Glossary for undertakings and conditions. His clinical supervisor must be appointed by his responsible officer (or their nominated deputy). b He must not work until: i his responsible officer (or their nominated deputy) has appointed his clinical supervisor and approved his supervision arrangements ii he has personally ensured that the GMC has been notified of the name and contact details of his clinical supervisor and his supervision arrangements.
8. He must not work: a as a locum b out-of-hours c on-call.
9. He must personally ensure the following persons are notified of the conditions listed at 1 to 8: a his responsible officer (or their nominated deputy) b the responsible officer of the following organisations: i his place(s) of work, and any prospective place of work (at the time of application) ii all of his contracting bodies and any prospective contracting body (prior to entering a contract) iii any organisation where he has, or has applied for, practising privileges and/or admitting rights (at the time of application) iv if any of the organisations listed at (i to iv) does not have a responsible officer, he must notify the person with responsibility for overall clinical governance within that organisation. If he is unable to identify that person, he must contact the GMC for advice before working for that organisation. c the responsible officer for the medical performers list on which he is included or seeking inclusion (at the time of application) d his immediate line manager and senior clinician (where there is one) at his place of work, at least 24 hours before starting work (for current and new posts, including locum posts).

4. a To have a workplace reporter approved by my responsible officer (or their nominated deputy) and to inform the GMC of these arrangements.

b Not to start/restart work until my responsible officer (or their nominated deputy) has approved my workplace reporter and this approval has been forwarded to the GMC.

5. a To design a personal development plan (PDP), approved by my responsible officer (or their nominated deputy), with specific aims to address the deficiencies in the following areas of my practice.

- Assessment of Patients' Condition

- Providing or Arranging Investigations

- Providing or Arranging Treatment

- Record Keeping

- Relationships with Patients

- Working with Colleagues

- Other Good Clinical Care – Use of Resources

b To give the GMC a copy of my approved PDP within three months of the date I agree these undertakings.

c To give the GMC a copy of my approved PDP on request.

d To meet with my responsible officer (or their nominated deputy), as required, to discuss my achievements against the aims of my PDP.

6. a To have an educational supervisor approved by my responsible officer (or their nominated deputy) and to inform the GMC of these arrangements.

b Not to start/restart work until my responsible officer (or their nominated deputy) has approved my educational supervisor and this approval has been forwarded to the GMC.

7. To undertake an assessment of my performance, on a date given by the GMC, unless notified by the GMC that this assessment is not necessary.

8. To share my performance assessment report dated June 2013 with:

a my employer and/or contracting body

b my responsible officer (or their nominated deputy)

c my immediate line manager at my place of work, at least one working day before starting work (for current and new posts, including locum posts)

d any prospective employer and/or contracting body, at the time of application

e the responsible officer of any organisation where I have, or have applied for, practising privileges and/or admitting rights, at the time of application

f my workplace reporter and educational supervisor and clinical supervisor

g the organisation on whose medical performers list I am included or seeking to be included, at the time of application

9. a To be supervised in all my posts by a clinical supervisor, as defined in the Glossary for undertakings and conditions. My clinical supervisor must be approved by my responsible officer (or their nominated deputy) and I must inform the GMC of these arrangements.

b Not to start/restart work until my responsible officer (or their nominated deputy) has approved my clinical supervisor and this approval has been forwarded to the GMC

10. To get the approval of my responsible officer (or their nominated deputy), and to inform the GMC of the approved arrangements before working:

a as a locum/in a fixed term contract, neither of which can be for less than 4 weeks duration;

b out-of-hours;

c on-call.

11. To confine my medical practice to general practice posts, where my work will be supervised by a named GP.

12. To have a mentor who is approved by my responsible officer (or their nominated deputy).

13. To inform the following persons of the undertakings listed at (1) to (12):

a my employer and/or contracting body

b my responsible officer (or their nominated deputy)

c my immediate line manager at my place of work, at least 24 hours before starting work (for current and new posts, including locum posts)

d any prospective employer and/or contracting body, at the time of application

e the responsible officer of any organisation where I have, or have applied for, practising privileges and/or admitting rights, at the time of application

f any locum agency or out-of-hours service I am registered with

g the organisation on whose medical performers list I am included or seeking to be included, at the time of application
