In this case, paragraph 22 of Good medical practice is particularly relevant: 22. You must treat information about patients as confidential ... You must follow our more detailed guidance on Confidentiality: good practice in handling patient information. Whilst this failing is not in itself so serious as to require any restriction on her registration, it is necessary in response to issue this formal warning.
