On 21 January 2025, Dr Singh accepted a police caution for damaging a vehicle with the intent to destroy or damage such property or being reckless as to whether such property would be destroyed or damaged, contrary to sections 1(1) and 4 of the Criminal Damage Act 1971. This conduct does not meet with the standards required of a doctor. It risks undermining public protection, specifically public confidence in the profession and professional standards and conduct, and it must not be repeated. The required standards are set out in Good medical practice and associated guidance. In this case, paragraph 81 of Good medical practice is particularly relevant: 81. You must make sure that your conduct justifies patients' trust in you and the public's trust in your profession. Whilst this failing in itself is not so serious as to require any restriction on his registration, it is necessary in response to issue this formal warning.
