On 27 December 2024, in an application for a post as a doctor, Dr Ward provided incomplete and misleading information about a GMC investigation into their fitness to practise. You must make sure any information you communicate as a medical professional is accurate, not false or misleading. This means: a. you must take reasonable steps to check the information is accurate. Whilst this failing in itself is not so serious as to require any restriction on Dr Ward's registration, it is necessary in response to issue this formal warning.
