On 25 November 2024 Dr Elsey accepted a community resolution order in relation to an incident that occurred on 2 June 2024 when she grabbed her child by their shoulders. This conduct does not meet with the standards required of a doctor. It risks undermining public protection, specifically public confidence in the profession and professional standards and conduct and it must not be repeated. The required standards are set out in Good medical practice and associated guidance. In this case, paragraph 81 of Good medical practice is particularly relevant: 81. You must make sure that your conduct justifies patients' trust in you and the public's trust in your profession. Whilst this failing in itself is not so serious as to require any restriction on her registration, it is necessary in response to issue this formal warning.
