The required standards are set out in Good medical practice and associated guidance. In this case, paragraph 81 of Good medical practice is particularly relevant: 81. You must make sure that your conduct justifies patients' trust in you and the public's trust in your profession. Whilst these failings are not in themselves so serious as to require any restriction on Dr Aziz's registration, it is necessary in response to issue this formal warning.
