On 9 April 2024 Dr Denysiak was charged with an offence of possession of a controlled substance (Marijuana) in Utah, America. Dr Denysiak was convicted of the offence on 27 November 2024 and received a probation period and a fine. Dr Denysiak failed to inform the GMC of the charge until 15 December 2024. This behaviour does not meet with the standards required of a doctor. It risks bringing the profession into disrepute and it must not be repeated. The required standards are set out in Good medical practice and associated guidance. In this case, paragraphs 81 and 99 of Good medical practice are particularly relevant: 81. You must make sure that your conduct justifies patients' trust in you and the public's trust in your profession 99. You must tell us without delay if, anywhere in the world: b. you have been charged with a criminal offence in person or by post c. you have been found guilty of a criminal offence. Whilst this failing in itself is not so serious as to require any restriction on Dr Denysiak's registration, it is necessary in response to issue this formal warning.
