On 12 August 2025 Dr Saougki was convicted of failing to provide a specimen for analysis, having been suspected of driving under the influence of alcohol. This behaviour does not meet with the professional standards required of a doctor. It risks undermining public protection, specifically confidence in the profession and it must not be repeated. The required standards are set out in Good medical practice and associated guidance. In this case, paragraph 81 of Good medical practice is particularly relevant: You must make sure that your conduct justifies patients' trust in you and the public's trust in your profession. Whilst this failing in itself is not so serious as to require any restriction on Dr Saougki's registration, it is necessary in response to issue this formal warning.
