1. Between 1 October 2022 and 5 December 2022 Dr Yakubu inappropriately accessed the confidential patient records of three individuals without legitimate reason, clinical need or consent. On more than one occasion when Dr Yakubu accessed these records, he was aware that safeguarding concerns had been raised in relation to these individuals. This conduct does not meet with the standards required of a doctor. It risks undermining public protection, specifically professional standards and conduct and it must not be repeated. The required standards are set out in Good medical practice and associated guidance. In this case, paragraph 81 of Good medical practice is particularly relevant: 81. You must make sure that your conduct justifies patients' trust in you and the public's trust in your profession. Confidentiality: good practice in handling patient information is also relevant. This states: 120. You must not access a patient's personal information unless you have a legitimate reason to view it. Whilst this failing in itself is not so serious as to require any restriction on Dr Yakubu's registration, it is necessary in response to issue this formal warning.
