On 8 July 2022, Dr Habeb accepted a caution for possession of a quantity of Cannabis, a Class B controlled drug. On or around 19 May 2022, Dr Habeb was charged via postal requisition with a criminal offence of which he was later acquitted. He failed to notify the GMC without delay that he had been charged. This behaviour does not meet with the standards required of a doctor. It risks bringing the profession into disrepute and it must not be repeated. The required standards are set out in Good medical practice and associated guidance. In this case, paragraphs 81 and 99 of Good medical practice are particularly relevant: 81. You must make sure that your conduct justifies your patients' trust in you and the public's trust in the profession. 99. You must tell us without delay if, anywhere in the world... a. you have accepted a caution (or equivalent) from a prosecuting authority b. you have been charged with a criminal offence in person or by post c. you have been found guilty of a criminal offence. Whilst this failing in itself is not so serious as to require any restriction on Dr Habeb's registration, it is necessary in response to issue this formal warning.
