On 28 March 2025 Dr Olayide was convicted of driving carelessly and at excessive speeds for the road, failing to stop at a roundabout and colliding with another vehicle (careless driving). The required standards are set out in Good medical practice and associated guidance. In this case, paragraph 81 of Good medical practice is particularly relevant: 81. Whilst this failing in itself is not so serious as to require any restriction on your registration, it is necessary in response to issue this formal warning.
