On 5 December 2025 Dr Appuhamy was convicted of aiding, abetting, counselling or procuring a minor to drive a motor vehicle otherwise than in accordance with a licence authorising him to drive a motor vehicle and allowing the use a motor vehicle on a road / public place without third party insurance. Furthermore, Dr Appuhamy failed to notify the GMC of these convictions/incidents. This conduct does not meet with the standards required of a doctor. It risks undermining public protection, specifically public confidence in the profession and it must not be repeated. The required standards are set out in Good medical practice and associated guidance. In this case, paragraphs 81 and 99 of Good medical practice are particularly relevant: 81. You must make sure that your conduct justifies patients' trust in you and the public's trust in your profession. 99. You must tell us without delay if, anywhere in the world: a. you have accepted a caution (or equivalent) from a prosecuting authority b. you have been charged with a criminal offence in person or by post c. you have been found guilty of a criminal offence Whilst this failing in itself is not so serious as to require any restriction on Dr Appuhamy's registration, it is necessary in response to issue this formal warning.
