On 13 November 2024 Dr Thandi was convicted of driving a motor vehicle on 26 October 2024, after consuming so much alcohol that the proportion of it in his breath, namely 55 microgrammes of alcohol in 100 millilitres of breath exceeded the prescribed limit. Dr Thandi was sentenced to a 12 month disqualification from holding or obtaining a driving licence, and an £800 fine. This conduct does not meet with the standards required of a doctor. It risks undermining public protection, specifically public confidence in the profession and professional standards and conduct, and it must not be repeated. The required standards are set out in Good medical practice and associated guidance. In this case, paragraph 81 of Good medical practice is particularly relevant: '81. You must make sure that your conduct justifies patients' trust in you and the public's trust in your profession.' Whilst this failing in itself is not so serious as to require any restriction on Dr Thandi's registration, it is necessary in response to issue this formal warning.
