On 13 August 2025 Dr Rayapah was convicted of driving a motor vehicle whilst having a proportion of alcohol in his system above the prescribed limit. This behaviour does not meet with the standards required of a doctor. It risks bringing the profession into disrepute and it must not be repeated. The required standards are set out in Good medical practice and associated guidance. In this case, paragraph 81 of Good medical practice is particularly relevant: You must make sure that your conduct justifies patients' trust in you and the public's trust in the profession. Whilst this failing in itself is not so serious as to require any restriction on Dr Rayapah's registration, it is necessary in response to issue this formal warning.
