On 3 December 2025 Dr Ganenthiran was convicted of driving a motor vehicle whilst having a proportion of drugs in his system above the specified limit. This behaviour does not meet with the standards required of a doctor. It risks undermining public protection, specifically public confidence in the profession and it must not be repeated. The required standards are set out in Good medical practice and associated guidance. In this case, paragraph 81 of Good medical practice is particularly relevant: 'You must make sure that your conduct justifies patients' trust in you and the public's trust in your profession.' Whilst this failing in itself is not so serious as to require any restriction on Dr Ganenthiran's registration, it is necessary in response to issue this formal warning. This warning will be published on the medical register in line with our publication and disclosure policy, which can be found at www.gmc-uk.org/disclosurepolicy.
