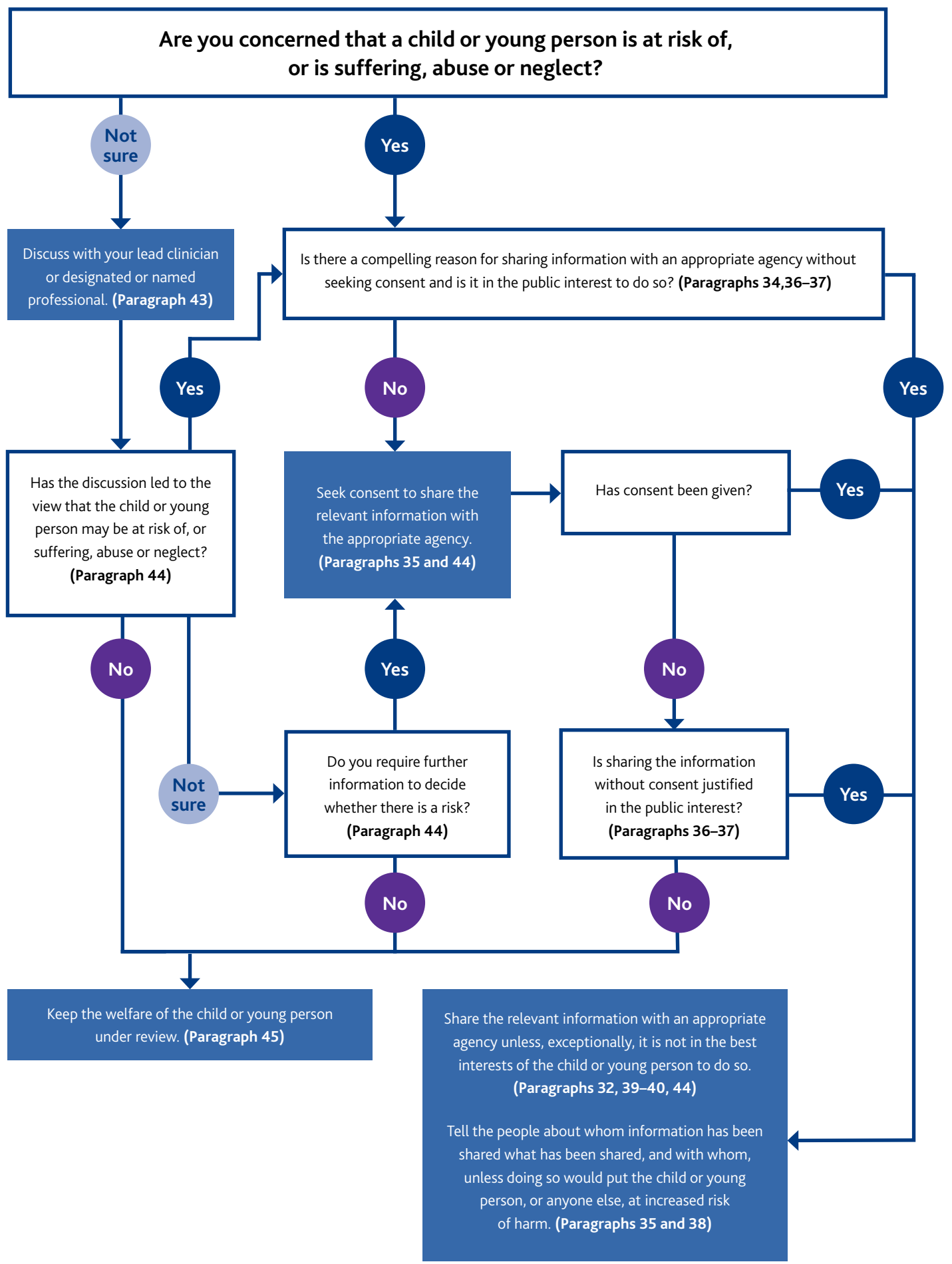


Making the decision to share information when you have child protection concerns



Keep the welfare of the child or young person under review. (Paragraph 45)

Share the relevant information with an appropriate agency unless, exceptionally, it is not in the best interests of the child or young person to do so. (Paragraphs 32, 39-40, 44)

Tell the people about whom information has been shared what has been shared, and with whom, unless doing so would put the child or young person, or anyone else, at increased risk of harm. (Paragraphs 35 and 38)
